

Little Missouri River Tributaries 319 Watershed Project

This 319 project is in its second year, providing cost-

share to producers to install Best Management Practices (BMP's) to improve the overall health of the watershed. These BMP's are designed to improve soil health which improves infiltration rates and reduces erosion. Reducing pollutants reaching the Little Missouri River. The 2018 BMP's in the projects included water developments and fencing for grazing rotations.

Solar System Program



Producers in Bowman & Slope Counties participated in a Solar System Program to convert fossil fuel powered pumping sources to solar powered pumps for livestock water. This is a grant the SCD received through the ND Department of Energy.
